## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROSTATE BIOPSY - FOR DIALYSIS PATIENTS**

- 1. Please do not take Aspirin or any kind of blood thinners for a week prior to the prostate biopsy.
- 2. Have your normal meals on the morning of the biopsy.
- 3. Do not take your blood pressure pill on the morning of the biopsy.
- 4. If you are diabetic take your diabetes medication as usual.
- 5. You have been provided a blood work requisition to be performed prior to your biopsy. Please do this test at any lab, no preparation, 1 2 weeks prior to your test.
- 6. Please also purchase a **FLEET ENEMA** from any pharmacy and use it on the morning of your biopsy. **Follow the enclosed instructions.**
- 7. You have been prescribed 2 different antibiotics. THESE ARE THE PROPER DOSES FOR DIALYSIS PATIENTS.
- I. Ciprofloxacin 500 mg ONCE DAILY to be started 1 day before the biopsy and continue for 3 days
- II. Fosfomycin (Monurol) 3g powder to be mixed in water and taken 2 hours before biopsy.

If after the prostate biopsy you notice fever or chills, please go to the nearest emergency and also call my office.
